 and forty seven To Have and To Hold the said negro Sarah above bargained
 and sold mentioned and intended so to be to the said Richard Meedon
 his executors administrators and assigns and I the said Elizabeth
 Meniken for myself my heirs executors and administrators
 the said negro Sarah unto the said Richard Meedon his Executors
 administrators and assigns against me the said Elizabeth Meniken
 my executors and administrators and against all and every other
 person persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and defend
 by these presents the said negro Sarah I the said Elizabeth Meniken
 have put the said Richard Meedon in full possession by deliv-
 ering to him the said Richard Meedon the said negro Sarah at the
 sealing and delivering of the presents in the names of the parties
 hereby bargained and sold or mentioned and intended to be unto
 him the said Richard Meedon as aforesaid. In Testimony whereof
