Know all men by these presents that I Freeborn G Waters Executor of Charles Waters dec'd of Baltimore City and State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and sixty dollars lawful money of the United States in hand paid by James I Waters of the City and State aforesaid at & before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said James his Executors Administrators and assigns one negro girl named Hager about ten years old of the property of Charles Waters late of the City of Baltimore dec'd as above to serve until the first day of May eighteen hundred and seventy (1870) and thereafter to be free and discharged from all servitude agreeably to the form and effect of the last will and testament of the said dec'd the said negro girl being sold and conveyed by me as Executor and in virtue of the power and authority vested in me by said last will and Testament To Have and To Hold the said described negro girl "Hager" for the term of years
