Know all men by these presents that Wm. Graham & Waters <sup>of the County of Baltimore</sup>  
Executors of Charles Waters dec<sup>d</sup> of Baltimore City and State  
of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and  
fifty dollars in hand paid by Henry A. Pulver of the City and State aforesaid  
and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is  
hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold unto by these presents  
do grant bargain and sell unto the said Henry Pulver his Executors ad-  
ministrators and assigns one negro girl named Margaret about  
seven years of age of the property of Charles Waters late of the City of  
Baltimore dec<sup>d</sup> as a slave until she arrives at the age of thirty years  
and thereafter to be free and discharged from all servitude agreeably to  
the form and effect of the last will & testament of the said dec<sup>d</sup>. The said  
negro girl being sold & conveyed by me as executor and administrator of the power  
and authority vested in me by said last will and testament. To have and  
to hold the said described negro girl Margaret for the term of years  
aforesaid but no longer to the said Henry Pulver his Executors administrators  
and assigns aforesaid. In Testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands  
and seals this sixth day of January eighteen hundred and forty seven
