


is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by their presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Joseph Pearson his Executors administrators and assigns my negro Girl named Thene aged about two years to be free first day of May eighteen hundred and sixty eight (1868) and one negro Boy named Rejin aged about eight years to be free first day of May eighteen hundred and seventy four (1874) of the property of Charles Waters late of Baltimore City dec'd. as slaves to whom the respective terms abovementioned & thereafter to be free and discharged from all servitude agreeably to the form & effect of the last will & testament of the said dec'd the said negroes being procured & conveyed by me as Executor in virtue of the power and authority vested in me by said last will and testament, To Have and To Hold the said described negroes Thene & Rejin for the terms of years aforesaid but no longer to the said Joseph Pearson his Executors administrators and assigns aforesaid
