 and five dollars lawful money of the United States in hand paid
 by Col John Berry of Baltimore County and State aforesaid
 before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these
 presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Col John Berry
 his Executors administrators and assigns one negro boy named Joshua
 now about eighteen years of age to be free 1st day of May 1861 and one
 negro man named Charles aged about thirty years to be free 1st day of
 January 1857 of the property of Charles Waters late of the City of Baltimore
 as slaves to serve until the times above stated and thereafter to be free and
 discharged from all servitude agreeably to the form and effect of the last
 will and testament of the said dec^d. The said negroes being sold and conveyed
 by me as executor and administrator of the said will and authority vested in me by
 said last will and testament To Have and To Hold the said described
 negroes for terms of years as aforesaid but no longer. In witness whereof we
 have hereunto set our hands and seals this sixth day of January eighteen
 hundred and forty seven
