





Bill of sale from F. G. Waters to Henry Johnson dated the 14<sup>th</sup> day of January 1847 } know all men by these presents that F. G. Waters Exr of Charles Waters dec<sup>d</sup> of Baltimore City and State of Maryland for and in

consideration of the sum of three hundred and seventy dollars lawful money of the United States secured by note to be paid by Henry Johnson of Anne Arundel County and State aforesaid and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Henry Johnson his Executors administrators and assigns one negro boy named Baird aged about seven years to be free on the first day of May eighteen hundred and seventy four (1874) and one negro man named Tom aged about forty seven years to be free first day of January eighteen hundred and forty nine (1849) of the property of Charles Waters late of the City of Baltimore dec<sup>d</sup> as slaves for the terms of years above stated and thereafter to be free & discharged from all servitude agreeably to the form and effect of the last will & testament of the said dec<sup>d</sup>. The said negroes being sold & conveyed by me as Executor and in virtue of the power & authority vested in me by said last will & testament. To Have and To Hold the said described Negroes Baird and Tom for the terms of years aforesaid but no longer to the said Henry Johnson his Executors administrators and assigns as aforesaid. In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals this 14<sup>th</sup> day of January eighteen hundred and forty seven
