Know all men by these presents  
that I Freeman G. Waters  
executor of Chas. Waters dec'd of Baltimore  
City and State of Maryland for and in

consideration of the sum of three hundred and thirty dollars lawful money of  
the United States in hand paid by Augustus Shinner of Carroll County in  
the State aforesaid at a before the sealing and delivery of these presents thereof  
whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents  
do grant bargain and sell unto the said Augustus Shinner his Executors admin-  
istrators and assigns one negro woman named Lee aged about twenty years to  
the first day of May eighteen and sixty (1860) and one negro girl named Kitty  
about three years old to be free when she arrives at the age of thirty one years of  
the property of Charles Waters late of the City of Baltimore dec'd as slaves to come  
for the term abovementioned and thereafter to be free and discharged from all servitude  
agreeably to the form and effect of the last will & testament of the said dec'd the  
said negroes being sold and conveyed by me as Executor and in virtue of the  
power and authority vested in me by said last will and testament To Have  
and To Hold the said described woman Lee & Kitty for the term abovementioned  
but no longer to the said Augustus Shinner his Executors administrators and  
assigns as aforesaid. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal  
this thirtieth day of January eighteen hundred and forty seven
