and in consideration of the sum of eighty five dollars lawful money of the United States secured by note to be paid by Joshua Stewart of Anne Arundel County & State aforesaid also before the calling and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Joshua Stewart his Executors administrators and assigns one negro boy aged about four years of the property of Charles Waters late of the City of Baltimore named Zach as a slave to serve until he arrives at the age of thirty five years and thereafter to be free and discharged from all servitude agreeably to the form and effect of the last will and testament of the said dec'd. The said negro Boy Zach being sold and conveyed by me as Executor and in virtue of the power & authority vested in me by said last will and Testament. To Have and To Hold the said described
