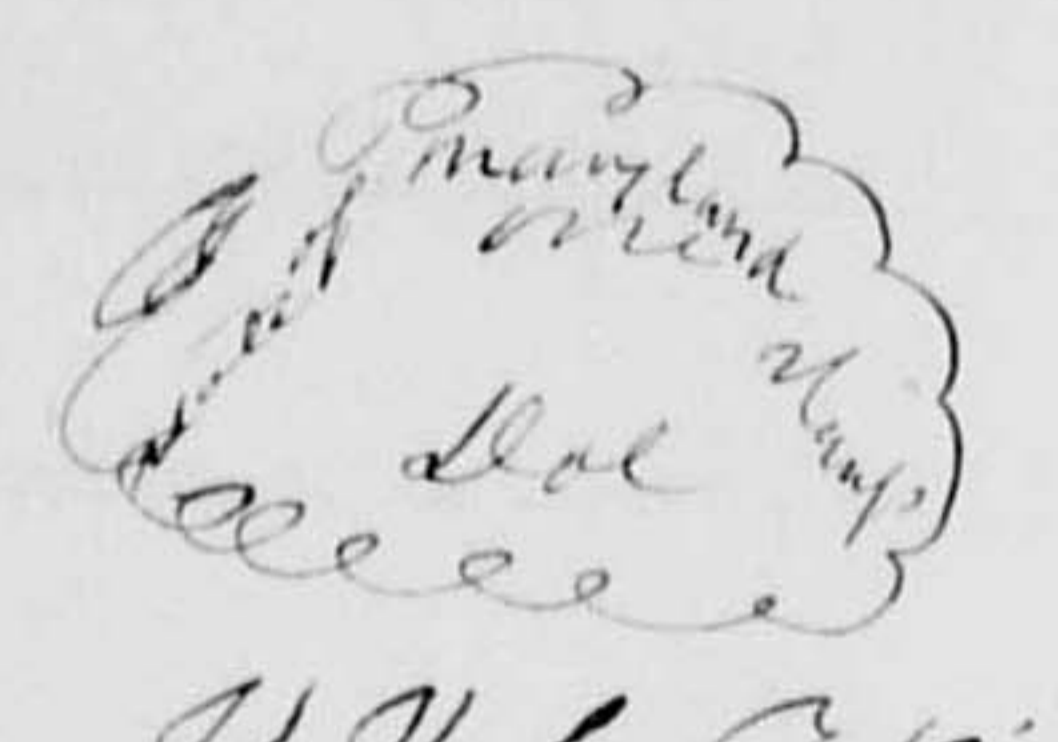

of the sum of three hundred & fifteen dollars law full money of the United States received to be paid by note by George D. O'Brien of Anne Arundel County & State as presided at a before the reading & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted & conveyed & sold they these presents do grant & sell unto the said George D. O'Brien his executor administrator & assigns one negro man named John aged about seventeen years brought out of the estate of Charles Waters late of Baltimore City deceased as above to serve until the first day of May eighteen hundred sixty four (1864) & thereafter to be free & discharged from service as usually to the form & effect of the last will & testament of the said deceased. This said negro being sold & conveyed by means & on the virtue of Bill of sale given by F. G. Waters Esq. of Charles Waters deceased bearing date 19th day of March 1847. To have & to hold the said described negro man John for the term of years as presided & no longer to the said George D. O'Brien his executor administrator & assigns as presided full witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands & seals this twenty second day of March eighteen hundred & forty seven
