Samuel E. Duval of Anne
Arundel County and State

of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred
and sixty dollars current money to me in hand paid by William
T. Gantt of the County aforesaid at and before the sealing and
delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknow-
ledged have granted conveyed and sold unto the said William T. Gantt
my negro woman Perry aged about fifty two years and law
ful wife. To Have and To Hold the said negro woman hereby granted
and sold unto the said William T. Gantt his Executors and
administrators and assigns in trust nevertheless to and for the
and separate use of Jane Gantt wife of Benjamin E. Gantt and
to be subject to her disposal by any deed or instrument of writing
under her hand and seal and acknowledged before any of the justices
of the peace in the same manner and to the like extent as if she
were sole and unmarried. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
