

Bill of sale from Gassaway Owens to Artidge E Owens dated the 21<sup>st</sup> day of April eighteen hundred & forty six

Know all men by these presents that I Gassaway Owens of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland

and for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars current money to me in hand paid by Artidge E Owens of Anne Arundel County in the State aforesaid at & before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof I the said Gassaway Owens do hereby acknowledge have granted conveyed and sold and by these presents do grant convey and sell unto the said Artidge E Owens his Executors administrators and assigns all the property hereinafter particularly mentioned that is to say one negro woman named Mary aged thirty three years one negro boy named George aged two years of which the said negroes is now in my possession To Have and To Hold the aforesaid negroes to the said Artidge E Owens his Executors administrators and assigns forever And I the said Gassaway Owens for my heirs Executors administrators and assigns the aforesaid negroes unto the said Artidge E Owens his heirs Executors administrators and assigns against me the said Gassaway Owens his heirs administrators and assigns and against all and every other person persons whatsover shall and warrant and power depend there presents which said negroes I the said Gassaway Owens have put the said Artidge E Owens in full possession by delivering to him the said Artidge E Owens the said negroes at the sealing and delivering of these presents in the name of the whole property here mentioned and intended to be owned by the said Artidge E Owens as aforesaid. In witness whereof I the said Gassaway Owens have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this twenty first day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty six Signed sealed and delivered Gassaway Owens
