Bill of sale from Henry Maynard to Henry Purdy & Galen Purdy dated the 27<sup>th</sup> day of April 1847

Know all men by these presents that I Henry Maynard of Anne Arundel County in the

State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Henry Purdy and Galen Purdy of said County and State as a before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof I the said Henry Maynard do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Henry Purdy and Galen Purdy their Executors administrators and assigns a certain negro woman and slave named Louisa supposed to be about twenty five years of age and certain other negro children of Louisa viz Aaron supposed to be one year of age Solomon supposed to be two or three years of age and an infant Grace supposed to be four months of age To Have and to hold the said Negro Woman named Louisa and her said Children named Aaron Solomon and Grace above bargained and sold or intended to be to the said Henry Purdy and Galen Purdy their Executors administrators and assigns forever
