To Have and To Hold the said Mare, above bargained and sold, or mentioned or intended, so to be, to the said William F. Leitch, his executors, administrators and assigns, for ever, and I the said Henry Mc Leitch, for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators all and singular, the said Mare, unto the said William F. Leitch, his executors, administrators and assigns, against me the said Henry Mc Leitch, my executors and administrators and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever, shall and will warrant and forever defend by these
