 said George D. Lyles, in the sum of Sixty dollars current money, and to
 secure the payment thereof is willing to execute these presents—

Now this indenture Witnesseth, that the said James Trainer, for and
 in consideration of the premises, and of the sum of five dollars, current
 money to him in hand paid by the said George D. Lyles, at and before
 the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt of which is hereby
 acknowledged, hath granted, bargained, and sold, and by these presents
 doth grant, bargain and sell, unto the said George D. Lyles, his executors
 administrators and assigns One Grey Mare about Five years old
 To Have and to Hold, the said Grey Mare, unto the said George D.
 Lyles, his executors, administrators and assigns, to his and their own
 use and behoof Provided always, and it is declared to be the true

intent and meaning of these presents, that if the said James Trainer do
 and shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid, unto the said George
 D. Lyles, his executors, administrators or assigns the full sum of Sixty doll-
 -ars current money, with legal interest for the same, on or before the thirtieth
 day of November, in the year of Our Lord Eighteen hundred and forty eight
 then and in such case these presents and every matter and thing herein
 contained shall cease, determine, and be utterly void, to all intents and
 purposes, any thing herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding
