the following negroes to wit Barbara, Mary, Ann, Lucy, Watt, Nace, Maria and Betty which said negroes were devised to the said Sarah Virginia <sup>Angelica</sup> ~~Elizabeth~~ Cooksey and Sarah Ann Amelia Cooksey children of the said William W. Cooksey by Marcus S. Warren late of Prince Georges County deceased as by reference to the will of said Marcus now of record in the offices of Register of Wills of said County will more fully appear

To Have and To Hold all the undivided interest of the said Richard J. Teyman and Laura Virginia Teyman his wife in and to the said Negroes, to the said William W. Cooksey his Executors Administrators and assigns forever and to and for no other use intent or purpose whatsoever
