In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and sealed this eighteenth day of May Eighteen Hundred and Forty Seven.



Cooksey the following negroes to wit Barbara, Mary, Ann, Lucy, Matt, Nace Maria and Betty which said negroes were devised to the said Laura Virginia Tayman by her husband William W. Cooksey and Sarah Ann Amelia Cooksey children of the said William W. Cooksey by Marcus S. L. Warren late of Prince Georges County deceased as by reference to the will of said Marcus now of record in the office of Register of Wills of said County will more fully appear.

To Have and To Hold all the undivided interest of the said Richard I. Tayman and Laura Virginia Tayman his wife in and to the said negroes, to the said William W. Cooksey his Executors Administrators and assigns forever and to and for no other use intent or purpose whatsoever.
