two hundred and fifty dollars of which sum I do hereby acknowledge the residue thereof to be paid to me or advanced to me as I and the said Firm shall determine have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell to Edward Reynolds One of the said Firm all the crops of wheat, Corn, Oats Tobacco and other crops the growth of this year now growing or that have grown on the Farm whereon I live on the West Side of South River in the said County To Have and To Hold the same unto the said Edward Reynolds his Executors administrators and assigns in trust nevertheless to possess himself thereof given time to time as they respectively mature or are ready for market and sell and dispose of the same in his discretion and apply the proceeds thereof to the payment of the said sum of money now advanced and the other sums of money that may be advanced as aforesaid until the whole sum of Six hundred dollars with the interest
