Bill of Sale from Freeborn

Know all men by these Presents, that I Free born G. Waters Executor of Charles Waters dec^d of Baltimore City and State of Maryland, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty five Dollars lawful money of the United States in hand paid by Susan Green of Anne

Arundel County, and State aforesaid at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged I have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents Do grant, bargain and sell, unto the said Susan Green her Executors, Administrators and assigns - One negro Boy, named Samuel about seven months old, to be free at Thirty five years of age, of the property of Charles Waters state of the City of Baltimore dec^d as a slave to serve until he arrives at the age aforesaid and thereafter to be free and discharged from all servitude agreeably to the form and effect of the last will and Testament of the said dec^d. The said Negro being sold and conveyed by me as Executor, and in virtue of the power and authority vested in me by said last Will and Testament - To Have and To Hold the said described Negro Boy Samuel for the term of years aforesaid, but no longer to the said Susan Green her Executors Administrators and assigns -
