To Have and To Hold the said crop of corn and fodder, and ten head of hogs to the said Stevens Gambrill his executors, administrators and assigns for ever, and I the said Isaac Chaney for myself my heirs, executors and administrators, the aforesaid crop of corn and fodder and ten head of hogs to the said Stevens Gambrill his executors, administrators and assigns, against me the said Isaac Chaney my executors and administrators, and against all and every person and persons whomsoever, shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents.
