 hath fully paid and satisfied to him the said Basil Shephard the above
 mentioned sum of money and interest thereon he the said Basil Shephard doth
 agree to execute this instrument of writing as a full release of the above
 described property. Now this indenture witnesseth that the said Basil
 Shephard stand in consideration of the payment of the above mentioned
 sum of money and the interest thereon and in consideration of the sum of
 one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Benjamin W. Brown stand
 before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt of which
 is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargain and sold unto the
 said Benjamin W. Brown his heirs and assigns forever the above mentioned and described
 Tobacco. To Have and to hold the said Tobacco unto the said Benjamin
 W. Brown his heirs and assigns to the only proper use of the said
 Benjamin W. Brown his heirs and assigns forever.
