I, George H. Grimes of Baltimore City and State
of Maryland, for and in consideration of the sum
of Two hundred dollars lawful money of the
United States in hand paid by Joseph Gray of

Anne Arundel County and State aforesaid at or before the sealing and
delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
Have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents Do grant, bargain
and sell, unto the said Joseph Gray his Executors Administrators and assigns
My negro man Jacob Johnson about forty nine years of age - The said
described Jacob Johnson To Have and To Hold Joseph Gray his Executors
administrators and assigns forever and I the said George H. Grimes
for himself his Heirs, Executors and administrators, The said Negro man
Jacob Johnson, unto the said Joseph Gray his Executors administrators
and assigns, against him the said George H. Grimes his Executors and
Administrators, and against all and every other person or persons what
soever, shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents
In Witness whereof, I have hereunto set his Hand and Seal this six-
teenth, day of October Eighteen Hundred and forty seven -
