 paid by the said Rignal Woodward at and before the making and  
 delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
 hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant  
 bargain and sell unto the said Rignal Woodward his executors  
 administrators and assigns one dark sorrel horse one white horse  
 now in the possession of the said Benjamin E. Gaunt. To have  
 and to hold the said Parcel Horse and White Horse above bargained  
 and sold to the said Rignal Woodward his Executors administrators  
 and assigns forever. And the said Benj E. Gaunt of himself his  
 heirs executors and administrators the said dark sorrel horse and  
 white horse unto the said Rignal Woodward his executors  
 administrators or assigns against him the said Benj E. Gaunt  
 his executors and administrators and against all and every other  
 person or persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and  
 defend by these presents.
