Holliday and Caroline Holliday do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said C. S. Fryer his executor administrator and assigns One Negro Girl "Phyllis" she and her issue to serve the said C. S. Fryer during the time of their natural heirs the said Phyllis now being in the possession of the said Fryer. To Have and to hold, the said Negro Girl "Phyllis" and her issue as slaves for life as above bargained and sold or meant, mentioned and intended to be, to the said C. S. Fryer his executor administrator and assigns forever, and we the said William S. Holliday and Caroline Holliday for ourselves our heirs executors and administrators the said Negro Girl Phyllis and her issue as slaves for life unto the said C. S. Fryer his executor administrator, and assigns against us the said William S. Holliday and Caroline Holliday our executors and administrators and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and will War-ant, and forever defend by these presents. In Witness whereof we the said William S. Holliday and Caroline Holliday have hereunto set our hand and affixed our seal this 28<sup>th</sup> day of March in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and forty Eight.
