Byrd of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, for and in consideration, of the sum of Five dollars current money of the United States to me in hand paid by James W. Allen also of Anne Arundel County, Maryland at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof I the said William H. Byrd

do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said James W. Allen his Executors, Administrators or assigns, a certain negro slave called Henry Ameer who was bound by Order of the City Court of Baltimore at September Term Eighteen hundred and forty six to the said William H. Byrd of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, until he shall arrive at the age of twenty One year and which said term will expire on the first day of October (1853) eighteen hundred and fifty three, the said Boy having been convicted, at said Sept. Term of Baltimore City Court of the crime of Felony - To Have and to Hold the said Negro slave Ameer, above bargained and sold, or intended so to be, to the said James W. Allen, his Executors, Administrators or assigns, to the said first day of October Eighteen hundred and fifty three and no longer -
