

Igglehart of Anne Arundel County in the State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of twelve hundred dollars lawful money to me in hand paid by John Igglehart of the same County and State aforesaid receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained, and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto him the said John Igglehart his executors administrators and assigns my negro woman Priss and her two children named Charlotte and Tim slaves for life To Have and to hold the said Negroes unto him in the said John Igglehart his executors administrators and assigns forever -
