Know all men by these presents, that I, James Peterson of Anne Arundel County in the State of Maryland, for and in consideration of sundry large sums of money due and owing, by me to John Randall and for the purpose and with the design of partially securing the said Randall

on account of the said sums of money due as aforesaid and for and in consideration, of the sum of ten cents current money to me in hand paid by the said John Randall of the said State and County at and before the receipt and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof I, the said James Peterson do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said John Randall his executors administrators, or assigns, all the right title and interest of me the said James Peterson of in and to the cart, gearing and the fixtures, herein mentioned with all my right title and interest of in and to the mare owned in part by me - both the cart gearing, and mare being now in the possession of Anthony Belt colored man who is also part owner thereof with me the said James Peterson -

To Have and To Hold the said right title and interest of me the said James Peterson of in and to the said above described property, to the said John Randall, his executors, administrators and assigns forever. And I, the said James Peterson, for myself my heirs, executors and administrators, the said cart, horse and gearing, so far as I have any claim, right or title to them or to any part thereof, to the said John Randall his executors and administrators against me and my executors and administrators, and against every other person, shall and will forever warrant and defend by these presents -
