Know all men by these Presents,  
That I Andrew J. Phelps administrator  
of James Phelps deceased of Anne Arundel  
County and State of Maryland for and  
in consideration of the sum of four hundred  
and fourteen dollars lawful money of the

United States in hand paid by Jonathan Warfield of said County and  
State at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt  
whereof is hereby acknowledged - Have granted bargained and sold, and by  
these presents Do grant, bargain and sell, unto the said Jonathan Warfield  
his Executors, Administrators and Assigns -


One Negro boy Aaron aged about twelve years the said Negro being a slave  
for life and formerly the property of James Phelps of Anne Arundel County  
now deceased -

To Have and To Hold the said described Negro slave for  
life to the said Jonathan Warfield his Executors Administrators and  
Assigns forever and I the said Andrew J. Phelps Administrator as afores-  
aid, for myself my Heirs, Executors and Administrators, the said Negro  
slave for life unto the said Jonathan Warfield his Executors, Administ-  
rators, and Assigns, against me the said Andrew J. Phelps administra-  
tor, as aforesaid Executors and Administrators, and against all and  
every other person or persons whatsoever, shall and will warrant and forever  
defend by these presents -
