Davis his executors administrators and assigns all the goods house hold stuffings elements, and furniture herein after particularly mentioned, that is to say One block with brass works One pair of Venetian blinds One pair round mahogany tables One Nurses chair (cane bottom) 2 d green bottom chairs two mahogany chairs with velvet bottoms One childs chair with cane bottom two stools One Mahogany ditto One Franklin stove One Wollen Carpet and rug One parlor Lamp (Lamp) One pair china vases twelve wooden bottom chairs One childs do, a lot of Matting, One Mahogany writing desk.
