Cromwell, for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators the said negroes Mary and Sidney unto the said Charles Too good his executors administrators and assigns against me the said Randolph S. Cromwell my executors and administrators and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever, shall and will warrant and forever defend, by these presents.
