Moss the following negro slaves now belonging to me and which slaves are now in the possession of said Ruth E. Moss and her husband Robert B. Moss, of Hackets Point in said County and State viz - negro Day about thirty five years old, Ruth about thirty three years old, and her children Casa Ann about fourteen years old, Mary about twelve years old, Maria about nine years old, Louisa about six years old, Nace about four years old, Bet about twenty five years old, and her sister Phoebe about twenty three years old, and her children John about six
