


Pherson do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said William Spence his executors administrators or assigns three horses, three cows, three carts, the household and kitchen furniture farming implements, now in my possession and the crops now growing on my farm in Anne Arundel County, so have and to hold all and singular the said horses & carts, cows, furniture farming implements and crops above bargained and sold, or mentioned and intended so to be to the said William Spence his executors administrators or assigns forever and I the said Samuel for myself my heirs, executors and administrators all and singular the above recited goods and chattels and other the premises unto the said William Spence his executors administrators or assigns against me the said Samuel M. Pherson my executors and administrators and against all and every other person or persons
