

Worthington at or before the sealing & delivery of these presents, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained & sold by these presents doth grant, bargain & sell, unto the said N. B. Worthington his executors, administrators & assigns one negro boy named David Ready a slave for life aged about nineteen years To Have and to Hold the said negro boy unto the said N. B. Worthington his executors, administrators & assigns, to the only proper use & behoof of the said N. B. Worthington his executors, administrators & assigns forever. Provided always & it is the true intent & meaning of these presents, that if the said Charles F. Worthington, his executors administrators or assigns shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said N. B. Worthington his
