

Worthington his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, the said sum of four hundred dollars with legal interest as aforesaid, without any deduction or abatement as aforesaid. And the said Charles F. Worthington for himself, his executors and administrators, the said negro boy by these presents granted, bargained & sold unto the said N. B. Worthington, his executors administrators & assigns, against him the said Charles F. Worthington his executors & administrators and against all & every other person or persons whatsoever shall & will warrant & forever defend by these presents. In Witness whereof the said Charles F. Worthington has hereunto subscribed his name and affixed his seal on the day & year first above written.
