 James McCulloh is known to me as the identical person

 of thirty dollars to me in hand paid by James Richard Colored man
 of the said County the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have
 granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and
 sell unto the said James Richards his executors administrators and
 assigns my negro female slave named Abigail aged about four
 years To Have and To Hold the said female slave unto the said James
 Richards his executors administrators and assigns from the day
 of the date of these presents until the first day of January in the
 year eighteen hundred and seventy two and not longer And be
 it further known that from and after the said last
 mentioned day and to date and to take effect from and
 upon the same and no before. I hereby for divers good and
 and sufficient causes and considerations me therein to moving
 manumit release from slavery and revivitate liberate and
 set free the said female slave named Abigail and her the said
 female slave I declare to be the free & good manumitted and
