Williams do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Edward C. Williams his executors administrators and assigns, the following negroes to wit: one negro man named Tom a slave for a term of years, whose term of service expired on the twenty third day of April in the year eighteen hundred and fifty five, also two other negroes named Stephen and Alick slaves for life all of whom are in the possession and employ of Edward C. Williams at present, as by reference to the last will and testament of Edward Williams in the office of Register of Wills of Anne Arundel County will more fully appear. To Have and to Hold all and singular the aforesaid property above bargained and sold, or mentioned or intended so to be to the said Edward C. Williams his executors, administrators and assigns forever. In Witness whereof we, the said John W. Williams and Edward C. Williams do hereunto interchangeably set our hands and seals on this fifteenth day of February in the year eighteen hundred and forty nine.
