


McKier his executors, administrators and assigns - In Witness whereof the said Alexander Randall and Thomas Shepherd McKier, have hereunto subscribed their names and affixed their seals the day and year first hereinbefore written.

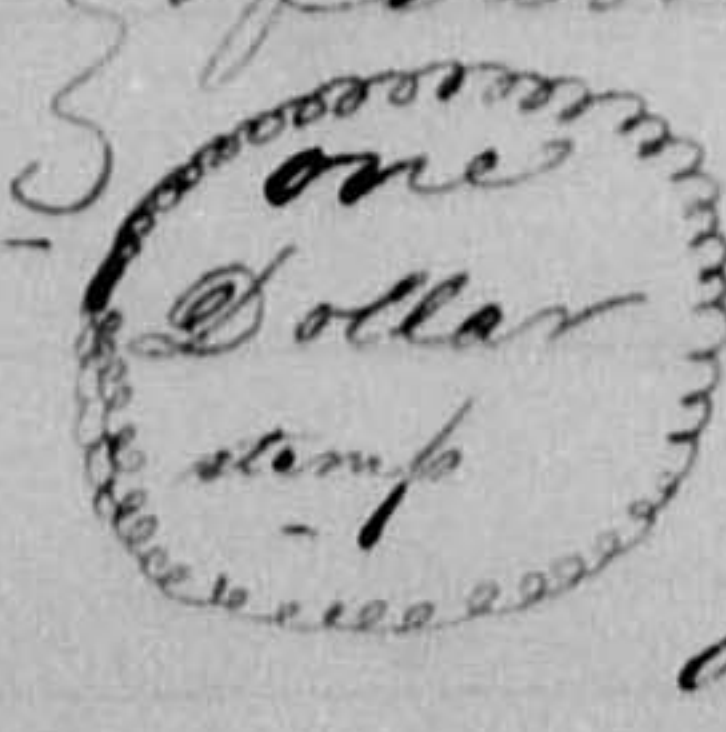

Arnold who hath held the same by virtue of the said legacy and hath now sold the said terms of service to Thomas S. Mezick - Now Know all men by these presents that the said Elijah R. Arnold for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars heretofore in hand paid by the said Thomas S. Mezick of Anne Arundel County the receipt whereof the said Arnold doth hereby acknowledge hath bargained, sold, assigned and transferred and delivered, all his the said Arnold's interest, right and
