Woodward her executors, administrators and assigns, three horses, one road wagon and harness, & one horse cart & harness, one bed, bedstead and bedding, half dozen chairs, one table together with all my household and kitchen furniture now in my possession - To Have and to Hold the said described property to the said Mary E. Woodward her executors, administrators and assigns forever - and I the said James M. Webb for myself my heirs, executors and administrators do by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said Mary E. Woodward her executors, administrators and assigns against me the said James M. Webb my executors and administrators and against all and every person and persons whomsoever, shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents - Provided nevertheless, in case I the said James M. Webb shall pay and satisfy to the said Mary E. Woodward, unto her executors and administrators or assigns, the sum of two hundred and twenty five dollars current money, then this Bill of Sale and every other matter and thing therein expressed, shall be void and of none effect.
