Waters aforesaid, by virtue of the power and authority contained therein, on or about the 19th day of November 1846 in Anne Arundel County at Waterford the County residence of said Charles Waters dec^d to the said Isaac C. Anderson, and the said F. S. Waters as Executor aforesaid, soon after said sale executed in due form of law and delivered to said Isaac C. Anderson a Bill of Sale for said boy, which Bill of Sale, as the said Anderson affirms has never been put
