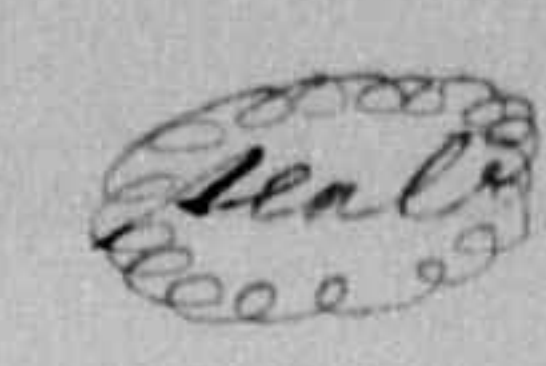
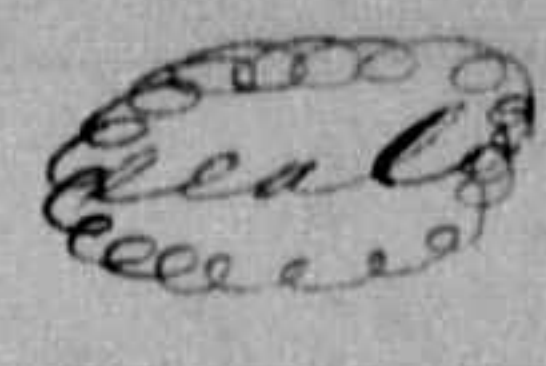

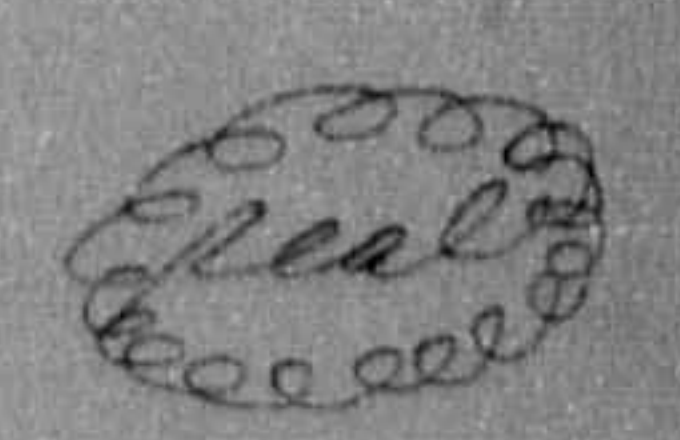

Dorsey Jacob & Know all men by these presents that J. Dorsey Jacob of Anne Arundel County, in the state of Maryland for and in consideration to John Jubb of the sum of forty eight dollars to me in hand paid by John Jubb of the said County, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said John Jubb his executors, administrators and assigns my negro slave named "Margaret" aged about two years. To Have and to Hold the said female slave unto the said John Jubb his executors, administrators and assigns from the day of the date of these presents untill the first day of May in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and seventy seven and not longer: and be it further known that from and after the said last mentioned day, and to the date and take effect from and upon the same and not before. I hereby for divers good and sufficient causes and considerations me therewith moving, manumitt, release from slavery and servitude, liberate and set free the said female slave named "Margaret" and her the said female slave I declare to be thenceforth freed, manumitted and discharged from all manner of service or servitude to me, my executors, administrators and assigns.
