the said Owen M. Taylor is willing to execute these presents. Now }
this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Owen M. Taylor found }
in consideration of the premises and of the sum of five dollars }
current money of the United States to him in hand paid by the said }
Sarah Ireland before the sealing and delivery of these presents the }
receipt whereof the said Owen M. Taylor doth hereby acknowledge }
he hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth }
grant bargain and sell unto the said Sarah Ireland her executors }
administrators and assigns all and singular the goods furniture }
and household stuff hereinafter particularly mentioned and }
expressed and now in his possession that is to say. Three Barrels }
of sugar two Bags of Coffee two Boxes of Meale and two Boxes of }
Soap one small chest of tea one Barrel of molasses six Barrels of flour
