

five as by reference to the ~~last~~ will and testament of Edward Williams in the office of the Register of Wills of Anne Arundel County will more fully appear To Have and To Hold the said negro "Tom" above bargained and sold or meant mentioned and intended so to be unto the said John W Stewart his executors administrators and assigns to his and their own proper use and behoof provided and it is declared to be the true intent and meaning of these presents that if the said Edward C Williams do and shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said John W Stewart his executors administrators or assigns the full sum of three hundred and fifty dollars current money with legal interest for the same from the date of these presents on or before the twentieth day of February in the Year Eighteen hundred and fifty one then and in such case these presents and every matter and thing therein contained shall cease determine and be utterly null and void to all intents and purposes any thing herein contained to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding And the said Edward C Williams for himself his executors and administrators and for every of them doth covenant grant promise and agree to and with the said John W Stewart his executors and administrators and assigns that he the said Edward C Williams his heirs executors or administrators shall and will well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said John W Stewart his Executors administrators or assigns the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars current money together with Interest for the same at such time and after such manner as is hereinbefore set forth and agreed upon for the payment of the same In Witness whereof the said Edward C Williams and John W Stewart have hereunto interchangeably set their hands and affixed their seals on the day and year first hereinbefore written
