 said described negro man Caesar Wallace to the said John
 H Hopkins his executors administrators and assigns forever
 and I the said Floyd Chaney for myself my heirs executors
 and administrators the said negro man Caesar Wallace unto the said
 John H Hopkins his executors administrators and assigns against me
 the said Floyd Chaney executors and administrators and against all
 and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and
 forever defend by these In Witness whereof ^{I have} hereunto set my hand and seal
 this twenty third day of May Eighteen hundred and fifty
