Davis do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Ann Hanshaw her Executors administrators and assigns all the goods household stuff implements and furniture herein after particularly mentioned that is to say fifteen beds headsteads and beddery seven dozen chairs three settees four bureaus three sideboards six dining tables eight small tables sixteen washstands barons and spittoons ten looking glasses large and small six dozen knives and forks four sets of china and odd pieces two dozen candlesticks and lamps twelve mirrors large and small twelve andirons shovels and tongs and fenders to suit two large chests and four trunks four stones two hundred yards of ^{1/2} feet together with all the kitchen furniture in the house situated in West Street in the City of Annapolis and now in the occupation of the said Edward A. Davis, all and singular which said goods and chattels are now remaining standing and being in a certain messuage or tenement situate in West Street in the City of Annapolis and now in the occupation of the said Edward A. Davis.
