Be it remembered, and it is hereby certified that on this  
twenty sixth day of October, eighteen hundred and fifty,  
personally appeared before the subscriber, a Justice of the Peace of the  
state aforesaid, in and for the County aforesaid, Samuel C. Hunt,  
he being satisfactorily proven to me, to be the person who is named  
and described as, and professing to be the party of the first part,  
to the foregoing Bill of Sale, and doth acknowledge the same  
to be his act and deed. At the same time before me  
came Jacob W. Bird Jun<sup>r</sup>, grantee named in the foregoing Bill  
of Sale, and made oath that the consideration in said Bill of Sale  
is true and bonafide as therein set forth.

hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and delivered,  
and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and deliver, unto  
the said Levi Pack, my negro woman Kitty Pack, about forty  
seven years of age, a slave for life, which said woman  
Kitty, will warrant and defend to the said Levi Pack, his  
Executors, Administrators and Assigns, against me, my  
Executors, Administrators and Assigns, and against every  
other person or persons whomsoever. In witness whereof, I have  
herunto set my hand, and affixed my seal this 16<sup>th</sup> day of  
October 1850
