Worthington, for myself, my heirs, Executors and Administrators, the said negroes above mentioned, unto the said Mary Weil as aforesaid, her Executors, Administrators and Assigns, against me the said Nicholas B. Worthington, my Executors and Administrators, and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever, shall and will
