Sutton, for myself, my heirs, my executors, and administrators, all and singular, the said negroes, goods, household stuff, implements, furniture and stock, and other the premises, unto the said Virginia R. Sothron, her executors, administrators and assigns, against me the said Philip D. Sutton, my executors, administrators, and against all, and every other person or persons whatsoever, shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents; of all and singular which said negroes, goods, household stuff, implements, furniture, and stock, and other the premises, I the said Philip D. Sutton have put the said Virginia R. Sothron in full possession, by delivering to her the said negroes, goods, household stuff, implements, furniture and stock, at the sealing and delivery of these presents. unto the said Virginia R.
