Donovan of the County and State aforesaid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge I have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Edwin W. Dewall agent as aforesaid a negro girl named Lulia the said Lulia being sound both in body and mind To Have and To Hold the said Lulia above bargained and sold a mean & mentioned & intended as to be to the said Edwin W. Dewall agent as aforesaid his executor administrators and assigns until the first day of December in the year eighteen hundred and fifty seven and then to be free manumitted and discharged from all manner of service & servitude whatever. And I the said William H. Norton will warrant and defend unto the said Edwin W. Dewall agent as aforesaid of Joseph S. Donovan and his assigns and against every other person whomsoever the said Girl Lulia as above granted bargained and sold

and twenty five dollars current money to me in hand paid by Edwin W. Dewall agent of Joseph S. Donovan of the County and State aforesaid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge I have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Edwin W. Dewall agent as aforesaid a negro girl named Lulia the said Lulia being sound both in body and mind To Have and To Hold the said Lulia above bargained and sold a mean & mentioned & intended as to be to the said Edwin W.
