and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said William  
Shipley his Executors administrators and assigns one negro boy named  
Joseph Werve until the first day of June eighteen hundred and  
seventy five, 1875, at which time he is to be free from all service and  
servitude To have and to hold the said described negro boy Joseph  
Werve until the first day of June 1875 to the said William Shipley his  
Executors administrators and assigns and I the said James H. Lee
