To of Anne Arundel County in the state of Maryland having
Edwin W. Durall heretofore applied to the Orphans Court of Anne Arundel County
Bill of Sale for leave to sell my negro slave Louis Piernan for a term of years
out of the state of Maryland and the said court having authorised me so to do by
their order passed on my petition on the second day of September last past. Have
this day for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars due in
hand paid by Edwin W. Durall the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged han-
dled set over and assigned and by these presents do transfer set over and assign
to the said Edwin W. Durall of the City of Indianapolis in Anne Arundel County
aforesaid the said negro Louis Piernan a slave for a term of years and to serve
forty years and six months he being now of the age of twenty two years and
being the same slave whom Susan Baldwin was by the said order authorised
to sell out of the state of Maryland for turbulent and vicious conduct and the
interest of the said Susan Baldwin being in the remainder of the said term of
years. To have and to hold the said slave Louis Piernan for and during
the rest and residue of his said term of years and no longer to the said Edwin
W. Durall and his executors administrators and assigns. In testimony
whereof the said Susan Baldwin and the said Edwin W. Durall have here-
unto set their hands and affixed their seals on this fifth day of September
in the year eighteen hundred and fifty one.
