Freedon his executors administrators and assigns one negro man named Nelson aged about twenty eight years, one negro man George aged about twenty two years negro woman Mary and her children Ann Spencer Maria and Harriett all of which property is now in my possession to have and to hold the same described property above bargained and sold to the said William S. Freedon his executors administrators and assigns forever to his and their only proper use and benefit, And I the said John Freedon for myself my executors and administrators shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents to the said William S. Freedon his executors administrators and against all and every other person or persons who ever claiming the same may part thereop.
